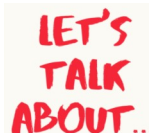


ELEVEN:18 YOUTH

Operation Christmas Child: April/May - New Clothing/Toys



Hallelujah! We are collecting new items for OCC shoeboxes once again! There is a crate in the foyer as you exit...let's fill 'er up! For April and May we're beginning with *new clothing* items (flip flops, bandanas, tee shirts, socks, underwear, etc.) and *new toys* (nerf type balls, small cars, kazoos, harmonicas, stuffed animals, puzzles, small dolls, etc.) for children ranging in age from 2-14 years old. Through Samaritan's Purse, Operation Christmas Child delivers shoe boxes filled with new items to children in over 100 countries along with the most important gift of all...the Hope and Love of Jesus Christ. At each distribution the gospel is shared at least three times and the little ones are given a booklet entitled 'The Greatest Gift'. Because of these boxes, children are introduced to the love and hope of Christ and they spread the word...families are saved and churches planted.
