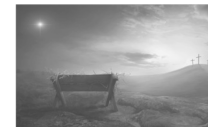

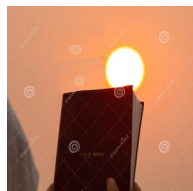
Operation Christmas Child: April/May - New Clothing/Toys
