Castlewood Canyon Hike: Saturday, June 26, 8:00am - 3:00pm

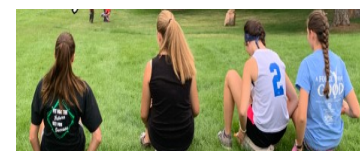
